Gelato Flavors Decoded

The Creams

Fior di Latte (*FYOR dee LAH-tay*) - Perhaps the base flavor for all cream (or even chocolate) flavors, this is literally “flower of milk” and it’s a wonderfully subtle sweet cream flavor. Some people I know think it’s boring, but I adore it.

Crema (*KREH-mah*) - This is a kind of egg custard flavor, and shouldn’t be confused with vanilla.

Zabaione (*zah-bah-YOH-nay*) - This is based on a dessert of the same name, made from egg yolks and sweet Marsala wine. So it’s an egg and custardy flavor, with an overtone of Marsala.

Cocco (*KOH-koh*) - Coconut

Caffè (*kah-FAY*) - From the masters of the espresso bean, here’s the gelato version.

Amarena (*ah-mah-RAY-nah*) - Though it has fruit in it, it’s a cream base. It’s basically Fior di Latte with a sauce of sour cherries mixed in. The cherries have been stewed in something, and I have no idea what it is, but they’re chewy and delicious, and you’re likely to get at least one whole cherry in your scoop.
